#### PREPARATION FOR COLONOSCOPY

For a safe and accurate examination, it is important that your colon is as clean as possible. Please read all the instructions carefully prior to your procedure.

You will need to purchase PREPKIT ORANGE (it contains 2 sachets of PICOPREP and 1 sachet of GLYCOPREP-O 70g) from your pharmacy. No prescription is required.

Follow the instructions below as they may differ from the instructions that come in the bowel preparation provided by your Pharmacist.

#### **FIVE DAYS BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY**

Avoid foods with whole grains, seeds or pips (ie grainy muesli, wholegrain/ multigrain bread, seeds and pips within fruit or vegetables). Continue avoiding these foods until after your procedure.

#### TWO DAYS BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY

Start the white diet. Only eat foods from the white diet food list (see over).

#### ONE DAY BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY

Prepare the bowel preparation in the morning of the day prior to your colonoscopy. The sachets should be mixed up separately (ie: into 3 separate containers), as follows:

- Mix 1 sachet of PICOPREP into 250mls warm water
- Mix 1 sachet of GLYCOPREP-O 70g into 1 litre of water
- Mix 1 sachet of PICOPREP into 250mls warm water

Chill these in the fridge until required.

On the day before your colonoscopy, can eat a WHITE DIET breakfast and lunch. No solid food is allowed after 3pm. Only APPROVED CLEAR FLUIDS and the bowel preparation are allowed until after your procedure.

- 1. At 6pm Drink 1 glass PICOPREP. Follow this by at least 4 glasses of clear fluids over the next two hours.
- At 8pm Start drinking the 1 litre of GLYCOPREP-C. Drink 1 glass every 15 minutes until finished. Slow down if your feel nauseous.
- At 9am the morning of your procedure .- Drink 1 glass of PICOPREP.
   Follow this with 4 more glasses of water.
- 4. You may drink water until your fast time

FAST COMPLETELY FROM 11am on the day of your procedure.

Plain cream cheese, cottage cheese, ricotta cheese, tasty cheese, feta cheese

Egg whites, mayonnaise, white sauce, cream, sour cream

White rice/pasta/peeled potatoes, clear soup

White bread/toast, plain rice crackers, rice bubbles

Grilled white fish fillet, chicken breast (no skin)

Any desired fluid

# **APPROVED CLEAR FLUIDS**

Water, clear broth, clear fruit juice (eg apple and pear), plain jelly, black tea or coffee (no milk), sports drinks (Gatorade, Powerade, Hydralyte), carbonated drinks, barley sugar, clear fruit cordials. Moderate alcohol is allowed but can dehydrate. Avoid red and green food colourings.

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# PREPARATION FOR COLONOSCOPY Patients with Gastric Lap Banding or Gastric Sleeve

For a safe and accurate examination it is important that your colon is as clean as possible. Please read all the instructions carefully prior to your procedure.

You will need to purchase 3 SACHETS OF PICOPREP from your pharmacy. No prescription is required.

Follow the instructions below as they may differ from the instructions that come in the bowel preparation provided by your Pharmacist.

#### **FIVE DAYS BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY**

Avoid foods with whole grains, seeds, nuts or pips (ie grainy muesli, wholegrain/ multigrain bread, seeds and pips within fruit or vegetables). Continue avoiding these foods until after your procedure.

#### TWO DAYS BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY

Start the white diet. Only eat foods from the white diet food list (see over).

#### ONE DAY BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY

In the morning of the day prior to your colonoscopy these sachets should be mixed up separately (ie: into 3 separate containers), as follows:

- Mix 1 sachet of PICOPREP into 250mls warm water
- Mix 1 sachet of PICOPREP into 250mls warm water
- Mix 1 sachet of PICOPREP into 250mls warm water

Chill these in the fridge until required.

On the day before your colonoscopy you may eat a white diet breakfast and early lunch NO SOLID FOODS after 1pm. Only APPROVED CLEAR FLUIDS and the bowel preparation are allowed until complete fasting time (see below).

- At 5pm -Drink your 1<sup>st</sup> glass of PICOPREP. Follow this by at least 4 glasses of clear fluids over the next two hours.
- 2. At **7pm**.-Drink 2<sup>nd</sup> glass of **PICOPREP**. Follow this by at least 4 glasses of clear fluids over the next two hours..
- 3. At **5am on day of procedure**-Drink your 3rd glass of **PICOPREP**. Follow this with 2 more glasses of **water**.

FAST COMPLETELY FROM 5.30am on the day of your procedure.

#### APPROVED CLEAR FLUIDS

Water, clear broth, clear fruit juice (eg apple and pear), plain jelly, black tea or coffee (no milk), sports drinks (Gatorade, Powerade, Hydralyte), carbonated drinks, barley sugar, clear fruit cordials. Moderate alcohol is allowed but can dehydrate. Avoid red & green food colours

#### AFTERNOON PROCEDURE

#### PREPARATION FOR COLONOSCOPY

For a safe and accurate examination it is important that your colon is as clean as possible. Please read all the instructions carefully prior to your procedure.

You will need to purchase GLYCOPREP ORANGE (210grams or 3 x 70g pkt) from your pharmacy. No prescription is required.

Follow the instructions below as they may differ from the instructions included in the bowel preparation provided by your Pharmacist.

### FIVE DAYS BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY

Avoid foods with whole grains, seeds, nuts or pips (ie grainy muesli, wholegrain/ multigrain bread, seeds and pips within fruit or vegetables). Continue avoiding these foods until after your procedure.

#### TWO DAYS BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY

Start the white diet. Only eat foods from the white diet food list (see over).

#### ONE DAY BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY

In the morning dissolve the 210 grams of GLYCOPREP-O in 3 litres of warm water and chill in the fridge until needed.

You may eat in moderate amounts of your WHITE DIET until 3pm. Only APPROVED CLEAR FLUIDS and the bowel preparation are allowed until after your procedure.

- At 6pm start drinking the first litre of GLYCOPREP-O. Drink 250mls every 15 minutes until finished.
- At 8pm start drinking the second litre of GLYCOPREP-O. Drink 250mls every 15 minutes until finished.
- At 9am the morning of procedure -start drinking the third litre of GLYCOPREP-O.
   Drink 250mls every 15 minutes until finished. This can be followed by 250mls of CLEAR liquid every hour until complete fast time.

FAST COMPLETELY FROM 11am on the day of your procedure

Milk, plain yoghurt, margarine/butter, vanilla ice cream/ lemon sorbet, white chocolate Plain cream cheese, cottage cheese, ricotta cheese, tasty cheese, feta cheese Egg whites, mayonnaise, white sauce, cream, sour cream White rice/pasta/peeled potatoes, clear soup White bread/toast, plain rice crackers, rice bubbles Grilled white fish fillet, chicken breast (no skin)

# APPROVED CLEAR FLUIDS

Water, clear broth, clear fruit juice (eg: apple and pear), plain jelly, black tea or coffee (no milk), sports drinks (Gatorade, Powerade, Hydralyte), carbonated drinks, barley sugar, clear fruit cordials. Moderate alcohol is allowed but this can dehydrate.

Avoid red and green food colouring.

# PREPARATION FOR COLONOSCOPY FOR PATIENTS ON GLP-1 RECEPTOR AGONISTS

You will need to purchase PREPKIT ORANGE (it contains 2 sachets of PICOPREP and 1 sachet of GLYCOPREP-O 70g) from your pharmacy. No prescription is required.

Follow the instructions below as they may differ from the instructions that come in the bowel preparation provided by your Pharmacist.

## FIVE DAYS BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY

Avoid foods with whole grains, nuts, seeds or pips (ie grainy muesli, wholegrain/multigrain bread, seeds and pips within fruit or vegetables). Continue avoiding these foods until after your procedure.

# TWO DAYS BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY

Start the white diet. Only eat foods from the white diet food list (see over).

#### ONE DAY BEFORE YOUR COLONOSCOPY

Prepare the bowel preparation in the morning of the day prior to your colonoscopy. The sachets should be mixed up separately (ie: into 3 separate containers), as follows:

- Mix 1 sachet of PICOPREP into 250mls warm water
- Mix 1 sachet of GLYCOPREP-O 70g into 1 litre of water
- Mix 1 sachet of PICOPREP into 250mls warm water

Chill these in the fridge until required.

On the day before your colonoscopy, can eat a WHITE DIET breakfast and early lunch. No solid food is allowed after 12pm. Only APPROVED CLEAR FLUIDS and the bowel preparation are allowed until after your procedure.

- At 6pm Drink 1 glass PICOPREP. Follow this by at least 4 glasses of clear fluids over the next two hours.
- At 8pm Start drinking the 1 litre of GLYCOPREP-C. Drink 1 glass every 15 minutes until finished. Slow down if your feel nauseous.
- 3. At 9am the morning of your procedure .- Drink 1 glass of PICOPREP. Follow this with 4 more glasses of water.

FAST COMPLETELY FROM 10am on the day of your procedure.

Milk, plain yoghurt, margarine/butter, vanilla ice cream/ lemon sorbet, white chocolate

Plain cream cheese, cottage cheese, ricotta cheese, tasty cheese, feta cheese Egg whites, mayonnaise, white sauce, cream, sour cream

White rice/pasta/peeled potatoes, clear soup

White bread/toast, plain rice crackers, rice bubbles

Grilled white fish fillet, chicken breast (no skin)

Any desired fluid

#### **APPROVED CLEAR FLUIDS**
